The Wahiawa Family Center is open and providing services for families experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness via our Prevention and Diversion programs. The new Family Center is located at Wahiawa Christian Church. We hope to open an Emergency Shelter program by early next year and are currently recruiting congregations in the Wahiawa, Mililani, Waipio, Waipahu, Aiea, and Pearl City areas to support our expansion.
